Fourth Annual “A Walk in the Park” Event Announced!

The Citizens for Brentwood Green Space recently announced their fourth annual “A Walk in the Park” event. This year’s festivities will take place at Marcella Vivrette Smith Park on Wilson Pike on Sunday, September 16, 2018.

The family-oriented “A Walk in the Park” event helps raise money for park enhancements at Smith Park, the largest park in the city limits of Brentwood. “We are more excited than ever for this year’s event,” said Gil Hutchinson, president of Brentwood Green Space. “Since 2015 our event has attracted over 500 attendees and raised approximately \$33,000 for the City of Brentwood’s parks.” Including private donations, total Greenspace donations for Smith Park are over \$212,000 to date.

This year’s title sponsor is once again H.G.
