PUFFY MUFFIN CONTINUES SUPPORT OF BRENTWOOD GREEN SPACE WITH LATEST MARDI GRAS INSPIRED ICED SUGAR COOKIES.

Brentwood-based Puffy Muffin Dessert Bakery & Restaurant has released its newest promotional Iced Sugar Cookies with two unique Mardi Gras inspired designs. The newest cookies continue a commitment made by the Puffy Muffin to donate ten percent of each cookie sale to The Citizens for Brentwood Green Space in 2017.

The Iced Sugar Cookie design is based on the heart-shaped Brentwood Green Space logo, but with an added twist that ties into a special event, celebration or holiday. “Our recent Valentine’s Day cookies were a huge hit,” said Kristi Elzinga, CEO of the Brentwood-based Dessert Bakery & Restaurant. “The response from the Brentwood community continues to be amazing.”

The special cookies were introduced to the Brentwood community at Brentwood Green Space’s second annual “A Walk in the Park” event at Smith Park on Sunday, October 30, 2016. The 2016 event attracted over 200 attendees and yielded a \$12,000 donation to the City of Brentwood’s for parks.
