CBGS presented to the City Commission a check in the amount of \$5,000 donated from Jeff and Susan Byrd at their June 13th meeting. Robert Jeffrey (Jeff) Byrd unexpectedly passed away in mid-April. He and his family were

avid supporters of the park and visited frequently.

The funds will be used towards improvements and amenities at Smith Park. With this donation, CBGS has now donated over \$310,000 to the City for park land acquisition and improvements.

Mountain Biking Trail Update

Local volunteer community group Bike Walk Brentwood (BWB) is working hard to make a mountain biking trail at Smith Park a reality. In conjunction with CBGS, over \$20,000 has already been raised towards the engineering study and trail's development. The group's discussions with the City are ongoing and the goal is to have trail development activities start in the fall!
