This involved a Knight stepping up to lead the forces. He gathered a group to assist in food preparation, serving and of course, cleaning. The meals included fried fish, Bake fish and numerous side items. The last Stations of the Cross service involved the youth presenting Live Stations. We also approached and invited the parish youth band to supply music on the last fish fry night. This group includes a Knight playing guitar with the kids. Over 200 people were served and enjoyed a wonderful meal and fellowship.

Although this project is not a fund raiser, it was very rewarding to support Father and bring the parish together during the Lenten season. This project did exactly what Father wanted, it brought our parish family together after the Stations of the Cross. The average Friday night involved a Knight leading the cooking, eight Knights preparing, and ten Knights cleaning. All in all, it gives us an opportunity for fellowship. Most importantly, we provided food and fellowship for our parish Priest. An average of 200 people enjoyed our meal each Friday night.

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This project accounted for 50 Knights and 300 man hours.
