Alcohol & Drug Use Policy

University of Fort Lauderdale has a clear

policy on the use of drugs and alcohol on school property. These policies are enforced by the university and are in line with the Federal, State, and local laws. The unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession or use of drugs in or on university owned or controlled property is prohibited. No member of the university community is permitted to report to work or class while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
